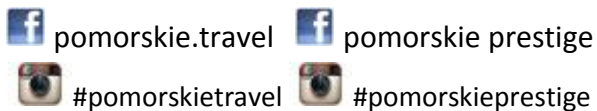

<p>11.00 – 13.00</p>	<p>Sightseeing of the Kashubian Ethnographic Park Museum www.muzeum-wdzydze.gda.pl/en_index.html</p> <p>The Teodora and Izidor Gulgowski Kashubian Ethnographic Park Museum in Wdzydze Kiszewskie is the oldest Polish open-air museum. The heritage park is a location extremely attractive to tourists, combining landscape, educational and recreational values. The picturesque developments of the former Kashubia and Kociewo farmsteads are recreated on 22 hectares located on the “Kashubian Sea” – the Wdzydze Lake District. Each of the 50 historical buildings presents a different image of the lives of Pomeranian villagers between the 18th and 20th centuries.</p>
