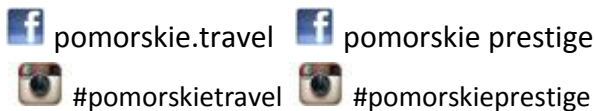

Among them are traditional Gdańsk duck, or zander with blue cheese and nuts. There is something in the menu for everyone, from beer snacks to large courses. The restaurant is also the only microbrewery in Gdańsk where three different kinds of beers are brewed. Brovarnia Lager, Dark and Wheat are all prepared according to traditional recipes, using latest brewing technologies.</p>
